This document provides everything you need to ensure a successful Moodmaker Soap Box Grand Prix team building activity.

# Ideally what's needed from the Venue

Soap Box Grand Prix can be organised **outdoors**, **indoors** or a **combination** of indoor (construction of the Soap Box) and outdoor (the race). Each have their distinctive features and specific needs.

For the **construction** of the Soap Box, we need a minimum area of 12m<sup>2</sup> per team. Bigger is always safer.

A large surface area is needed for the actual **race**. For your comfort and safety, the race should take place on an area without obstacles, bumps or slopes, and if outdoors, preferably on a grass field.

Please note that under no circumstances can we have the race on public roads.





#### Venue - Outdoor

If there is a **chance of rain**, a tent (3m x 3m) **must be provided** per team (additional cost). It is Moodmaker who makes the final decision on this.

These tents may also be appropriate in warm weather to provide shade for the participants.

Construction of the Soap Boxes can be done on a hard surface (e.g. parking lot), for the race we prefer a grass field, for your comfort and safety.

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- Checklist Soap Box GP -

#### Venue - Indoor

As we use robust materials and the Soap Boxes are also painted, we can only allow the Soap Box GP to take place indoors in a **warehouse** or **shed**.

Moodmaker is under no circumstances responsible if there is damage to the building (e.g. due to dropped parts or paint spots).





#### Bad weather / Rain

As mentioned earlier, without exception, tents must be provided per team if there is a chance of rain.

Moodmaker reserves the right to cancel the Soap Box Grand Prix if the activity cannot proceed safely due to weather conditions, such as heavy rain, snow, wind, flooded or swampy terrain,... It is Moodmaker who makes the final decision on this.

If possible, we will provide an indoor alternative. This is subject to our availability and the indoor capabilities of the venue.





### Logistics



For the Soap Box Grand Prix, we bring a lot of equipment, up to more than 2.000kg for large groups. This seems like a lot (and it is), but with our good logistics system, we can handle this without any problems.

These materials are transported with a large van (length : 6m00, height : 2m60). **A parking space in the immediate vicinity of the location is required**.

Indoor : All our materials are transported on roll cages (see image). Floors without lift or steps that prevent us from reaching the room while rolling must be communicated in advance so that we can plan ahead or provide extra crew (additional cost).

**Outdoor** : for a fluent build-up, we need to be able to drive the van on the site. If we cannot drive on the site, we provide extra crew (additional cost).





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#### Participants

By default, we make **groups of 7 people**. This depends on the timing, surface area of the field, background of participants,... Moodmaker will decide the group size according to these factors.

Notify the participants of the nature of the activity and the outdoor aspect. Appropriate clothing and footwear is recommended. This can range from a raincoat to sun cream. Backup clothing may be convenient.

When constructing the Soap Box, there is a creative part : painting and decorating. For this we use acrylic paint (this is the only paint that covers sufficiently). Stains are difficult to wash out! Take this into account.

Moodmaker will provide aprons for the participants.





Timing

- **Setup** : 1,5 to 2 h before the event
  - **Event** : Soap Box GP takes approximately 2,5 to 3 hours
    - This includes the introduction, construction of the Soap Box, the race and dismantling the Soap Box by the participants.

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• **Cleanup** : 1 h after the workshop.



#### **Food & Drinks**

#### No Alcohol Before or During the Activity :

Alcohol signals the end of the business portion and can lead to unprofessional behavior during the team building.
